4s Possum and Wombat

In this final teachers' report of term 3 I would like to focus on what's happening on-site as the Kinderloop showcases our online program.

Currently we have children attending our preschool on 2 days a week: Monday and Thursday. The children are from both 4 year-old groups and on Monday we have also a child from Kookaburra group attending. We don't have many children attending each session, the maximum so far has been 6 children per day.

During our kinder sessions we focus on offering the children 'wellbeing experiences' that include nature, art, singing and sensory activities. Children experiment exploring open-ended activities and create art and games using different media. You can admire some of their artworks I have included in this report that explore science and art: colour absorption, pattern, numeracy, painting and creativity (see page 2 as well).

We have been enjoying our yard at kinder, exploring nature and water play, and observing the changes in plants in our yard as spring arrived. The children have been enjoying interactions with their peers and prolonged times of uninterrupted play, an important part of their emotional and social development.

We have also been singing, reading books and engaging in meaningful conversations with the children. New friendships have formed and the children are showing great resilience and strong emotional regulation and self-help skills. They should be as proud of themselves as we are of them!

Thank you to all the staff for being so flexible and making these sessions work. We can't wait to see all the children back with us in term 4, we miss you!!
